

Chairman's Message



It is pleasing to report that the club successfully got through the Easter festivities, masks and all. I congratulate all members for giving staff very little grief in complying with this restriction. On behalf of members, I would also like to extend my sincerest appreciation to all staff who had the onerous and uncomfortable obligation of having to wear masks at all times for the entire two weeks.

The State Government has thrown the club another Covid-19 curve ball. From Saturday, 1 May all businesses, including hospitality, must use the **Check In Qld**, QR code application to register entry to the club. Details of how to download and use the app have been included in this newsletter. The club has already commenced use of the app.

For the duration of the Queensland Covid health directive, which will be with us for some time yet, this system replaces the current signing in regulations under the Liquor Act as well as the Covid-19 contact tracing requirements. For those who do not have mobile phones, reception staff will assist you in registering via the business version of the app.

QR codes are in place on the dining room window as you walk towards the club's main entry as well as at reception. It is also a requirement that the courtesy bus must have its own QR code. This will be displayed on the bus and again the driver will assist those who do not have mobile phones.

I see this latest directive as a positive step which will simplify and make accessing all businesses

consistent. The regular argument from patrons that they do not have to do at other venues what this club was making them do, should stop. Staff will be very grateful as the constant dealing with these cases has taken its toll on them, believe me.

While members do not now have to swipe their membership cards in and out of the club, I remind everyone to swipe your cards at the kiosk at the entry to the gaming room, to earn loyalty points, receive birthday bonuses and check balances.

The Easter weekend saw the opening of the new Greenside Bar. I wish to thank Gavin and Wallace from builders, CDC Projects, who generously removed and replaced the temporary hoarding on the Saturday to make this possible, as the roller door had not arrived on time.

Since then, this area has been used on numerous occasions with great success and the enquiries and forward bookings are outstanding. To brighten up the area, a tiled feature wall has been created and new dry bars and casual furniture purchased. The bar is now open on Friday and Sunday afternoons. Rink 15 on Friday afternoon has become very popular all of a sudden.

To facilitate better use of this area for barefoot bowls and to overcome some of greenkeeper, Dipper's concerns, all barefoot bowls, except for Friday evenings, is now to be played on Green 3 and in an east-west direction. There was damage happening to all greens through barefoot bowls activity, so, to limit the damage, this strategy will be implemented. Apart from Fridays, if

numbers are greater than the capacity of Green 3, which will be set to 8 rinks, times will be set and patrons will just have to wait and hopefully make use of the bar.

This club will shortly be leading the way with the introduction of an online games booking system. Bowls Manager, Timbo and Ladies Games Director, Jenny, have been busy setting up this facility. For those not tech-savvy, systems have also been put in place to cater for those members as well, so don't be afraid.

The system is due to go live very soon so Timbo will be advising all members of that date and provide full details. For those wishing to have a look and possibly make preliminary use of it, please visit the club's website, www.coolumbeachbowls.com.au, click on **Bowls** then **Social Bowls**, scroll down to the event you wish to enter, click on that event then follow your nose. It is that simple. There are bound to be teething problems, so be gentle on those you seek for help.

- * Passes above the face of the bank
- * Passes completely outside a side boundary of the rink of play
- * Comes to rest in any hollow in the face of the bank
- * Comes to rest at a distance of less than 21 metres as measured in a straight line from the centre of the mat to the nearest point of the jack.
